



MUSICAL JOURNEY: Local musician Jack Mantis is returning to Cape Town after the first leg of his world tour. Mantis left the Mother City at the end of May in 2013 aboard a small sailing vessel headed for Brazil with stopovers in Luderitz in Namibia and St Helena in the middle of the Atlantic Ocean. He also made several other stops in Port Natal, Trinidad, Tobago, Miami, LA and across the USA. On his return Mantis will perform at the Baxter Theatre on Saturday 30 August, at the Hub in Scarborough from Thursday 4 to Saturday 6 September at the The Red Gallery in Tokai. While on tour Mantis played for and with the locals residents in every single place he landed. He also filmed and documented the entire first leg and is currently editing the first of a three-part full-length feature titled *Till everything is illuminated*.
